Rivers Alive & Project WET updates

• RA cleanups have been going well and we are looking forward to getting more numbers in. We've had great success this cleanup season.

- Over 200 events registered
- Over 9,800 volunteers so far
- Approximately 1,030 miles cleaned
- Nearly 332,000 lbs of trash collected
- WET will hold a Triple Facilitator Workshop (WET, WILD, and PLT) on February 21-22, 2020 at Jekyll Island. In early March we will present our WET awards at the annual EEA Conference. ROW art and poetry submissions are due February 1.
