
ID KEY: When interpreting the 3M Petrifilm plates...


- If the colony is growing along the edges but still in the medium, count it. If the colony is half way on the medium and half off, DO NOT count it. ۶
- Red colonies with or without gas bubbles are general coliforms ۶
- ۶
- Blue to red-blue colonies with gas bubbles are *E. coli* colonies When the entire plate looks like a red smear because of general coliforms, any blue to red-blue colonies with or without gas bubbles are counted as *E. coli* ≻
- \triangleright
- Plates that have <u>one or more</u> of the following are considered TNTC: Many small colonies, many gas bubbles, and a deepening of the gel color from red to purple-blue ≻




